You may bring anything else you prefer to grill also, such as veggie burgers or steaks.

Guests of all types are welcome! Bring friends from Church or LGBT friends. Bring the kids! You can also bring your dog (especially if he is better behaved than the kids!)

Driving Directions are given below. If you can provide a ride for someone else from your area, let me know. There is also Alexandria DASH bus service past the park hourly on the AT-5 line, however the Metro Stations in Alexandria are closed for construction at this time.

Driving Directions

From I-395 Southbound: exit at King Street (Route 7) East. After crossing the bridge over 395, take the first right onto Menokin Street. Go one block and turn right onto Van Dorn Street. Continue to West Braddock (next intersection) and turn left. Proceed on West Braddock for about 1/2 mile and the park entrance will be on your left.

From I-395 Northbound: exit at Seminary Road East. Continue to the 4th traffic light, which is Howard Street (Alexandria Hospital will be on your right). Turn left. Howard ends at West Braddock. Turn right and the park entrance will be a short distance ahead on your left.
